Hello, Quilters!

I’m excited that you’ve joined us for this 2020 Fall edition of my Mystery Quilt! Twice a year (Spring & Fall) I create and post my Mystery Quilt Steps out on my Blog (QuiltingWithLori.com/blog/).

For this Fall’s Mystery quilt pattern, I decided we quilters needed some *fun and fellowship*, so I’m offering the FREE Mystery Steps on ZOOM on Monday nights, **starting Monday, October 19, 2020 at 7:00 PM (CST)** (The rest of the Sessions will be: Oct 26, Nov 2 and Nov 9, 2020... all at 7:00 PM CST)

Since there are 4 steps to this Mystery pattern, there will be 4 Free Zoom sessions where I will discuss & present each step of the pattern with you and answer any questions you have. Because there are some quilters who have joined who are not familiar with Mystery Quilts, I am going to offer a few more HINTS for this particular Mystery Quilt Pattern (specifically regarding fabric selection)!

For next Monday night’s Zoom Session, be thinking about the fabrics you would like to pull from your stash for this “*Fall Fields of Four*” Mystery quilt! I’ll go into detail on fabric selection on Monday night!

Hint Number One: Think Fall colors and Fall leaves! In fact, grab some of those fabrics that you might want to choose for the quilt and have them ready for Monday’s session...you can always change your mind on your fabric selection once you’ve watched the Zoom session next week! You will not begin cutting & piecing Step Number One until AFTER the Zoom session ends!

If you miss a Zoom session, *No Worries!* I will post the session out on my Blog by the next morning, along with the next PDF of instructions so you can continue working on your Mystery Quilt! Yardage for Fall Fields of Four Mystery Quilt:

Light Background fabric for Blocks A & B and diamond border blocks: 2-7/8 yards total

Bright Medium Fabric for Blocks B and diamond border blocks: 2-7/8 yards total

Dark Fabric for Blocks B, Corners of border and outside border 7/8 yard total

Leaf Blocks A: Bright Fall Colors Qty (8) **Different** Fat Quarters
