## Step Two:

Hourglass Blocks: Make (8) blocks

## Cut from Fabric (Or) Pull from Your Scrap Stash:

1. Light Background Fabric:

- (8) 7 " squares
- (32) 3.5 " squares

2. Dark Fabric:

- (32) 3.5 " squares

3. Bright (Medium) Fabric:

- Cut (8) 7" squares


## A. 4-Patch Units:

a. Make 4-patch units with 3.5 " Light squares \& 3.5 " Dark squares.
b. Two 4-patch units are needed for each of the 8 blocks.
c. Square up each 4 -patch unit to $\mathbf{6 . 5 "}$
d. Press seams to the dark whenever possible

B. Create Half Square Triangles: (See steps in photos below)
a. Place a Light 7" square RST with a 7" Bright (Medium) square. Draw a diagonal line from one corner to opposite corner. Sew a scant $1 / 4$ " seam allowance on EACH side of the drawn line.
b. Cut on the drawn line to create two HST squares.
c. Open each HST and press to the dark side.
d. SQUARE UP each of the HST's to 6.5 " using a 6.5 " square-up ruler.
e. Each Hourglass Block requires (2) HST's.


Piece the Hourglass blocks: (see photos below)
f. Piece (2) 4-patch units and (2) HST units together as shown in photo.
g. Be sure to orient each of the 4-patch units and the HST units correctly. Follow the photos below.
h. Also, be sure there are $1 / 4$ seam allowances available on outer edges of the HST units, so you won't lose the 'points' when all the blocks are sewn together. (See Black Ovals in photo below which indicate where the available $1 / 4$ " seam allowance should be.)
