**Pumpkin Block – 12.5” Unfinished**  
Using “Speedy Solutions Scrap Techniques” by Lori Dickman



**Scrap Squares Required:**

- Qty. (25) 2.5” Orange (various pumpkin-colored) squares
- Qty: (1) 2.5” Brown square (stem)
- Qty: (2) 2.5” Cream squares
- Qty: (2) 2.5” x 4.5” Cream strips
- Qty: (2) 1.5” x 12.5” Cream Strips

**Directions:**

1. Create (4) HST Corner units by placing Cream/Pumpkin squares WST; draw a diagonal line; sew ON the diagonal line. Trim away the excess; press open & square up to 2.5”.
2. Sew the pumpkin in (5) rows of (5) squares. (Sew the HST squares on the outer 4 corners of pumpkin to create the curve of the pumpkin!)
3. Sew the top row by sewing the 2.5” brown square between the (2) 4.5” cream strips
4. Sew the outside (2) 1.5” x 12.5” borders to the block.

Square up the block to 12.5”
