

Pumpkin Block – 12.5" Unfinished Using "Speedy Solutions Scrap Techniques" by Lori Dickman



Scrap Squares Required:

Qty. (25) 2.5" Orange (various pumpkin-colored) squares

Qty: (1) 2.5" Brown square (stem)

Qty: (4) 2.5" Cream squares

Qty: (2) 2.5" x 4.5" Cream strips

Qty: (2) 1.5" x 12.5 Cream Strips

Directions:

- 1. Create (4) HST Corner units by placing Cream/Pumpkin squares WST; draw a diagonal line; sew ON the diagonal line. Trim away the excess; press open & square up to 2.5".
- 2. Sew the pumpkin in (5) rows of (5) squares. (Sew the HST squares on the outer 4 corners of pumpkin to create the curve of the pumpkin!)
- 3. Sew the top row by sewing the 2.5" brown square between the (2) 4.5" cream strips
- 4. Sew the outside (2) 1.5" x 12.5" borders to the block.

Square up the block to 12.5"
