## Sedona Block

Dimensions of Quilt: 58" x 58"
Finished Block size: 12" x 12 "
Hi, Quilters!
Do you have your (8) Block A's finished (Weather Vane blocks)? I look forward to seeing your finished blocks during the call on Monday evening!

With all my Mystery Quilt classes, you can use your scrap stash! For those of you who may not have your scraps cut, organized \& ready to use, watch my video (link HERE) which teaches you how!

NOTE: The Zoom Classes for Monday, Oct 10 \& Monday, Oct 17 will be held at 7:00 PM CST (Central Standard Time). There will only be one class on each of those evenings \& everyone who plans to jump on the call will do so at 7:00PM CST. (So, be sure to determine what time it is in YOUR time zone BASED on Central Standard Time.)

## Fabrics required:

Dark Fabrics: $11 / 2$ yards
Medium Fabrics: $11 / 2$ yards
Light: $13 / 8$ yards
Backing: $3^{1 / 2}$ yards Binding: $1 / 2$ yard

## Fabrics for the Quilt:

## Cut from yardage or Pull from Scrap Stash:

## For Block A:

Dark Fabrics: (8) $4.5 "$ squares; (32) $2.5 "$ squares
Mediums Fabrics: (32) $2.5 " \times 4.5 "$ rectangles [Or, pull (16) $5 "$ squares $\&$ trim $1 / 2 "$ off one side and cut each resulting square into (2) $2.5 " \times 4.5 "$ rectangles for a total of (32) rectangles.]
Light Fabrics: (32) 2.5" squares
HST's: (32) 3" squares Dark and (32) 3" squares Light
Flying Geese Units: (16) 4" Medium squares; (32) 3" Light squares

## For Block B:

Darks fabrics: (80) 2.5 " squares
Medium Fabrics: (64) 2.5" squares
Light Fabrics: (80) 2.5 " squares
HST’s: (32) 3" Light squares; (32) 3" Dark squares

## For Corner Border Blocks:

Dark Fabrics: (4) $2.5 "$ x $4.5 "$ rectangles [Or, pull (2) 5 " squares \& trim $1 / 2$ " off one side and cut each resulting square into (2) $2.5 " \times 4.5 "$ rectangles for a total of (4) rectangles]; (4) 2.5 " squares; (8) 1.5 " squares

Light Fabrics: (8) 1.5 " squares

## For Border Blocks:

Dark Fabrics: (192) 1.5" squares
Medium Fabrics: (48) 2.5" x $4.5 "$ rectangles [Or, pull (24) 5" squares \& trim $1 / 2$ " off one side and cut each resulting square into (2) $2.5 " \times 4.5 "$ rectangles for a total of (48) rectangles ]
Light Fabrics: (192) 1.5 " squares

## Directions:

## Block B: (Make 8 Blocks)

Create HST's using the 3 " Light squares \& the 3" Dark squares.

Place a Light \& Dark square RST; draw a diagonal line across the square; sew scant $1 / 4$ " SA on EACH side of drawn line. Cut on drawn line. Press toward the Dark seams. SQUARE UP each HST to 2.5".
 Make a total of (64) HST's.


Create Flying Geese units using the Lt/Dark HST's. Create a Flying Geese unit by sewing two HST squares together as shown. Be sure to orient the two HSTs correctly to create the Flying Geese unit. Square up the Flying Geese units to 2.5 " $\mathbf{x} \mathbf{4 . 5 "}$. (This week, we are learning a $2^{\text {nd }}$ technique for using your Scrap Squares to construct flying geese units by simply using two HST units!) Make a total of (32) Flying Geese units.


2-Patch units: Create 2-patch units using the Medium \& Dark 2.5" squares. Make (16) pair of EACH orientation.


Create "Flying Geese 4-patch Units": Create 4-patch units using a Flying Geese unit, and a Med/Dk 2-patch unit. BE SURE to orient the 2patch unit under the Flying Geese unit correctly. Make (16) "Flying Geese 4-patch units" with the Medium square on the Left; and (16) "Flying Geese 4-patch units" with the Medium square on the Right! Then, square up Flying Geese 4-patch Units to 4.5".

## Create 4-patch Units:

Create a total of (24) Lt \& Dark 4-patch units and (16) Light \& Medium 4-patch units for the quilt using the $2.5 "$ Light, Medium \& Dark squares. (See photo at right...) Square up each of the 4-patch units to 4.5"


Layout Block B as follows: Note: (Orient the 4-patch Units \& the "correct" Flying Geese 4patch Units within each Row as shown in illustrations below.)


Row One: Lt/Dark 4-patch Unit; Flying Geese 4-patch Unit; Lt/Medium 4-patch Unit.


Row Two: Flying Geese 4-patch Unit; Lt/Dark 4-patch Unit; Flying Geese 4-patch Unit.


Row Three: Lt/Med 4-patch Unit, Flying Geese 4-patch Unit; Lt/Dark 4patch Unit.

Sew the (3) rows together for each block.
