Fabric scraps to pull from your stash:

Total 2.5" squares needed for <u>EACH</u> block: (12) Red (Mediums); (12) Green (Darks); (12) Cream (Lights)

Being sure to sew the Cream-colored (light) blocks on the "right side" of each of the 9-patch units (**as shown in diagram below**) create **FOUR** 9-patch units using the following squares:


- (3) Red 2.5" squares
- (3) Green 2.5" squares
- (3) Cream 2.5" squares





Square up each of the 9-patch units to 6.5" x 6.5".

Next, sew the 9-patch units together into a "4-patch Block", rotating each 9-patch unit to create the pattern shown in diagram below: (Watch Video tutorial for additional instruction.)



Once your block is sewn together, square it up to 12.5".

You can either add this block to your **52-Week Series of Scrappy Blocks** to create a Sampler quilt, or you can make more of this great block and create a Christmas Quilt for your Holiday Décor!

Holly Berry Center Block Finished: 12" square Make 1



Corner Blocks Finished: 4" x 4" square Make 4

Border Rectangles Finished: 40" x 4"; Make 4



Fabrics:

* Variety of Fat Quarters: (4) **each** of reds, greens, and creams for the Scrappy blocks (or pull 2.5" squares from your scrap stash as noted in "Scrappy Christmas Block" instructions (previous page). PLUS, grab an extra Green Fat Quarter for the applique Holly leaves.

1-yard cream for the Center background Square, (4) Corner background squares, and (4) Swags

1-yard Dark Green for sashing and outside borders

1-yard Dark Red for border rectangles

3 yards Backing Fabric

- Follow instructions for the "Scrappy Christmas Block" (previous page). Create a total of (8) Scrappy Blocks.
- Cut one 12.5" x 12.5" Light Background square; and (4) 4.5" Light Background Corner squares.
- Use your favorite method of applique to create the Holly & Berry Center block, the Corner Blocks, and the Border Swags. (Use templates attached to this pattern.). Cut out all the applique elements from the appropriate color of fused fabric (for fusible applique). Applique the elements to the appropriate color backgrounds, either Light background squares or Red rectangle borders. (**See cutting info for red borders below.)
- Cut (16) 1.5" Red Cornerstones; Cut (24) 1.5" x 12.5" Green Sashing's.
- Sew the (8) Scrappy Blocks and the (1) Center Holly Berry Applique block together with green sashing between the blocks. (See photo above for correct placement of all blocks, sashing, and cornerstones.)
- Sew (4) rows of green sashing with red cornerstones.
- Sew the rows of scrappy blocks w/green sashing to the rows of Sashing w/cornerstones to create the quilt center.
- **Cut (4) 40.5" x 4.5" Red borders. Applique the Cream Swag (centered) onto each red rectangle.
- Cut (2) 48.5" x 1.5" outside Green Borders & cut (2) 50.5" x 1.5" outside Green Borders.
- Sew (2) of the appliqued Swag Borders to the quilt sides.
- Then, add a Corner applique block to **each end** of the last two Swag Borders and sew them to the remaining two sides of the quilt.
- Sew the Green outside borders to the quilt.
- Your quilt is now ready to be quilted, bound and labeled! Enjoy!
