Weather Vane

12.5” Unfinished

Fabrics for the Quilt:

Cut from yardage or Pull from Scrap Stash:

Dark Fabrics: (1) 4.5” squares; (4) 2.5” squares

Mediums Fabrics: (4) 2.5” x 4.5” rectangles [Or, pull (2) 5” squares & trim ½” off one side and cut each resulting square into (2) 2.5” x 4.5” rectangles for a total of (4) rectangles.]

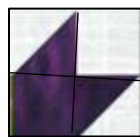
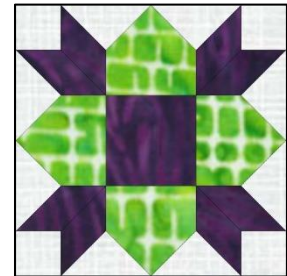
Light Fabrics: (4) 2.5” squares

HST’s: (4) 3” squares Dark and (4) 3” squares Light

Flying Geese Units: (2) 4” Medium squares; (4) 3” Light squares

Directions:

Create HST’s using the 3” Lights & 3” Darks. Place a Light & Dark square RST; draw a diagonal line across the square; sew scant ¼” SA on EACH side of drawn line. Cut on drawn line. Press toward the Dark seams. **SQUARE UP the HST to 2.5”**. Make a total of (8) HST’s for the block.



HST 4-patch Units: Create 4-patch units using (2) HST’s, a 2.5” Dark square and a 2.5” Light square as shown in photo at left... be sure to orient the HST units in the correct position to create the 4-patch unit correctly. Make a total of (4) of these 4-patch units for the block. **Square up HST 4-patch units to 4.5”**.

Flying Geese Units: Cut each of the (2) 4” Medium squares on the diagonal once to create a total of (4) Larger Base Triangles for the base of the Flying Geese unit. Then, cut each of the (4) 3” Light squares on the diagonal once to create a total of (8) Smaller Triangles.

Sew the smaller triangles on each side of the Larger Base Triangle, as shown in photo (right). Make a total of (4) Flying Geese units. **Square up each to 2.5” x 4.5”**.



To complete the Flying Geese unit, sew a 2.5” x 4.5” Medium Fabric rectangle to the bottom of each of the (4) Flying Geese patches as shown at left. **Square up each completed Flying Geese unit to 4.5” square**.

Layout Block A as follows:



Row One: HST Unit; Flying Geese Unit; HST Unit



Row Two: Flying Geese Unit; 4.5" Dark square;
Flying Geese Unit.
(Be sure to orient EACH of the Flying Geese units in
the correct position.)



Row Three: HST unit, Flying Geese Unit; HST unit.

Sew the (3) rows together for each block.
Square up each Block to 12.5"
