

## "Old Maid's Puzzle" block 12.5" x 12.5"

<u>History of this block:</u> It was often featured in 19<sup>th</sup> century Amish quilts.

## Fabric scraps to pull from your stash:

For **EACH** block, pull or cut:

Lights: (4) 3.5" squares; (5) 4" squares (for HST units)

Mediums & Darks: (2) 3.5" squares; (5) 4" squares (for HST units)

## Create block:


1. Create the center 4-patch unit w (2) Light 3.5" squares & (2) Med/Dark 3.5" squares. Square up the 4-patch unit to 6.5".



2. Create HST units by placing a Light 4" squares RST with a Med/Dark 4" square. Draw a diagonal line; sew scant 1/4" on EACH side of diagonal line. Cut on diagonal line. Press open to dark side. Square up EACH HST unit to 3.5". Total of (10) HST's are needed for EACH block.



- 3. Lay out each block as shown (below) ENSURING that the HST units are ORIENTED correctly within each row.
- 4. Sew the Old Maid's Puzzle Block together as follows:



Row One: Light 3.5" square; and then (3) HST units.



Row Two: HST unit; Light 3.5" squares; Med/Dark 3.5" square and HST unit.



Row Three: HST unit; Med/Dark 3.5" square, Light 3.5" square, HST unit.




Row Four: (3) HST units and a Light 3.5" square.

Press to the dark when possible. Square up the block to 12.5"
