"Hearts & Flowers" block 12.5" x 12.5"

Fabric scraps to pull from your stash:

For **EACH** block, pull or cut:

Lights: (1) 12.5" Background square Mediums: (4) 5" squares for Hearts, (1) 5" square for flower buds Darks: (3-4) 5" squares for the leaves & stems

Create block:


- 1. Using fusible web, trace the elements from the PDF onto the paper side of the fusible web. NOTE: Ignore the ¹/₄" seam allowance lines when using fusbile web; trace on the darker lines. Those ¹/₄" seam allowances are for Needle-turn Applique.
- 2. Group 'like' items next to another to conserve fusible. Loosely cut around each grouped set of elements and fuse them to the WRONG side of the appropriate fabric.
- 3. Once fused, cut out the fused fabric elements ON the dark line; remove the paper.
- 4. Press the 12.5" background square in fourths so you have crease lines to guide you as you place the elements on the square.
- 5. Once you are pleased with the placement (be sure to leave at least ½" all around outside for seam allowance and a bit of light background showing...) then press the elements to the block.
- 6. Set up your machine for applique... use complimentary, contrast or monofilament thread. Applique each element. Use either an edge-stitch, blanket stitch, or a zig-zag stitch for applique.

Your "Hearts & Flowers" Block is ready to use!
