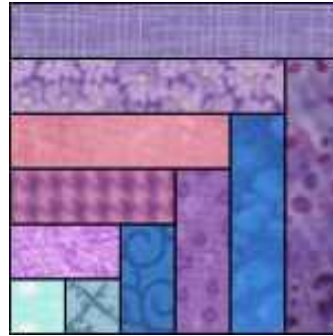




Log Cabin on Point QuiltingWithLori.com Lori Dickman



Quilt Dimensions: 92" x 92"
Block: 12" x 12" (Finished sizes given)
Sashing: 2" x 12" (Finished)
Cornerstones: 2" x 2" (Finished)
Borders: 2" Wide Inside Borders and 4"
Wide Outside Borders
Square up measurements: 4.5", 6.5", 8.5",
10.5" and 12.5"

Cutting for **EACH** block:

Sub-cut the 2.5" strips into the following units:

- (2) 2.5" squares
- (2) 4.5" rectangles
- (2) 6.5" rectangles
- (2) 8.5" rectangles
- (2) 10.5" rectangles

Only (1) 12.5" rectangle

Create a TOTAL of (41) full Log Cabin Blocks (some will be used for setting triangles), (64) 2.5" x 12.5" sashes and (40) 2.5" corner stones.

Fabrics: 7 yards total for blocks; 2.25 yards for sashes and inside border; 1.75 yards for outside border. (If using Jelly Rolls, quilt requires 4 jelly rolls, plus border fabric.)
