“Stargazing with Clay” block 12.5” x 12.5”

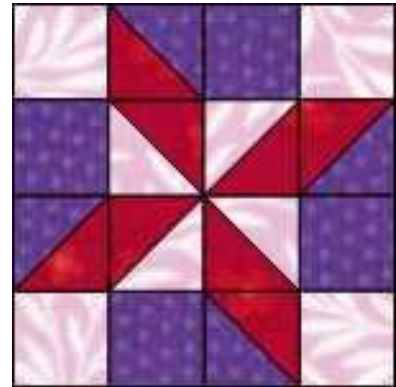
Fabric scraps to pull from your stash:

For EACH block, pull or cut:

Lights: (4) 3.5” squares; (2) 4” squares for HST’s

Mediums (Red): (4) 4” squares for HST’s

Darks (Purple): (4) 3.5” squares, (2) 4” squares for HST’s



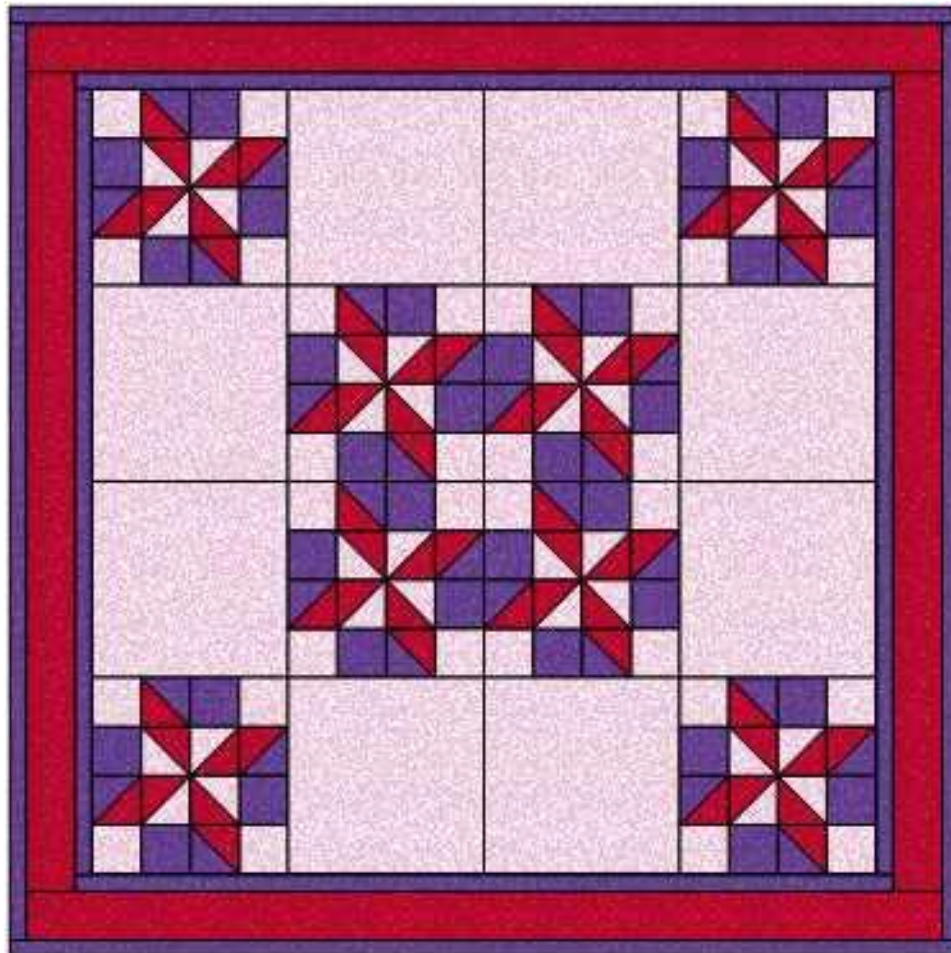
Create block:

1. First, make the HST’s using the 4” squares. Place a Light with a Medium (RST) and a Dark with a Medium (RST – right-sides together). Draw a diagonal line. Sew a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ ” on EACH side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line. Press to the darker side. Square up EACH HST unit to 3.5”. Make a **total of (4) Light/Medium HST’s and a total of (4) Dark/Medium HSt’s.**
2. Using the diagram of the “Stargazing with Clay” block (above), lay out the 3.5” squares in 4 rows of 4 columns as shown.
3. Sew the block together. Press rows toward the bottom of the block; press the columns to the right of the block.
4. Square up each completed block to 12.5”

Your “*Stargazing with Clay*” Block is ready to use!
