
"Colorado in the Spring" block 12.5" x 12.5"

Fabric scraps to pull from your stash:

For **EACH** block, pull or cut:

Lights: (8) 4" squares for HST's Medium-A: (2) 4" squares for HST's Medium-B: (2) 4" squares for HST's Darks: (4) 4" squares for HST's



Create block:


- First, make the HST's using the 4" squares. Place (2) Lights with Medium-A's (RST) and (2) Lights with Medium-B's (RST). Also place (4) Lights with Darks (RST – right-sides together). Draw a diagonal line. Sew a scant ¼" on EACH side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line. Press to the darker side. Square up EACH HST unit to 3.5". Make a total of (4) Light/Medium-A HST's; (4) Light/Medium-B HST's; and (8) Light/Dark HST's.
- 2. Using the diagram of the "Colorado in the Spring" block (above), lay out the 3.5" HST's in 4 rows of 4 columns as shown. Be sure to ORIENT each of the HST units as shown in each row.
- 3. Sew the block together. Press seams to the darker side whenever possible.
- 4. Square up each completed block to 12.5"

Your "Colorado in the Spring" Block is ready to use!
