



# Mystery Quilt Spring 2023

## Stars in My Eyes

### Introduction and Supply List:

It's that time of year again! We all get to experience how to use up our Speedy Solutions Scrap Stash to make beautiful quilts and this Spring's Mystery Quilt *Stars in My Eyes* will be one of your favorites!

If you don't already have your scrap stash cut, sorted, organized and ready to go to make beautiful quilts, be sure to watch/listen to my YouTube video tutorial here: [LINK](#)

If you do NOT have a scrap stash, NO WORRIES! All my patterns offer yardage to create the quilt. The yardage required for *Stars in My Eyes* is as follows:

Light fabrics: 3 yards  
Medium fabrics: 1-1/4 yards  
Dark fabrics: 2 yards

I do want to point out that, often, students like to wait to choose their fabrics AFTER Mystery Quilt Session #1... that way they have a better idea of what they want to use, but if you've made a number of my Mystery Quilts, you might be ready to jump right in!

Here is the Zoom Class schedule:

**MQ Session #1: Monday, April 3, 2023 at 7PM (CST – that is CHICAGO time, so “google” what time it is in your area based on Chicago time...**

**MQ Session #2: Monday, April 10, 2023 at 7PM (CST)**

**MQ Session #3: Monday, April 17, 2023 at 7PM (CST)**

For those of you who are ambitious and want to get all your scraps ready for the quilt classes, here is what you'll need to [PULL FROM YOUR SPEEDY SOLUTIONS SCRAP STASH](#): (I like to gather my scraps in a plastic bin and have them ready at my sewing machine!) If you do *not* have your Speedy Solutions scrap stash ready from which to Pull your scraps, then you'll want to **CUT** the required amounts noted below before making the blocks (this is where many students hold off until *after* watching the first Zoom session! Then, they begin their Mystery adventure!):

**Block 1: Make 9**

Lights: (36) 3.5” squares, (36) 4” squares for HST's

Mediums: (36) 4” squares for HST's

Darks: (36) 4” squares for HST's

**Block 2: Make 4**

Lights: (4) 5" squares; (8) 5" squares

Mediums: (8) 5" squares

Darks: (16) 4" squares

**Setting Triangles:** (4) Lights: 13" squares

**Setting Corners:** (2) Lights: 9" squares

**Borders:**

(NOTE: I like to teach a Pieced border technique for every Mystery Quilt that I create. However, you can simply use plain borders or any type of border you choose!)

**Pieced Border Squares:**

**Lights:** enough 2.5" strips to create (40) 10" x 2.5" triangles (template will be provided); and enough 2.5" strips to create (8) 2.5" x 5.5" triangles & REVERSE (8) 2.5" x 5.5" triangles (templates will be provided).

**Mediums:** 1.5" strips... enough to create (48) 1.5" x 3" triangles (template will be provided); and 3" strips...enough to create (48) 3" x 3" triangles (template will be provided)

**Darks:** (12) 5" squares (cut in half to create (24) 2.5" x 5" rectangles

**Border Corner Squares:**

Lights: (8) 3" squares

Mediums: (8) 2.5" squares

Darks: (4) 2.5" squares

**Inside Borders:**

Dark: (4) 1.75" x 51.5" (pull 2" strip stash and trim to 1.75" wide)

Mediums: (4) 1.75" squares (pull 2" squares & trim ¼" off two sides)

**Outside Borders:**

Darks: (2) 1.5" x 61.5" and (2) 1.5" x 63.5"
