Scrap Block Quilt Sampler – 52-week Series

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**“Kitty in the Corner” Scrappy Block  
12.5” x 12.5”**

**Fabric scraps to pull from your stash:**

For **EACH** block, pull or cut:

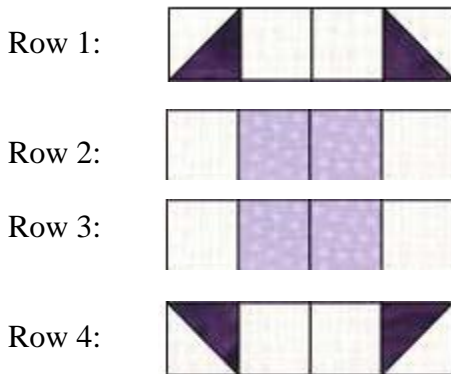
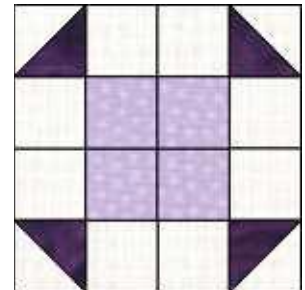
**Lights:** (8) 3.5” squares, (2) 4” squares (HST units)

**Mediums:** (4) 3.5” squares

**Darks:** (2) 4” squares (HST units)

**Create block:**

1. Create the (4) HST units as follows:
  - a. Place a Light & Dark 4” square RST; draw one diagonal line from corner to corner; Sew a SCANT ¼” SA (seam allowance) on EACH SIDE of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line. Open and Press to the dark. Square up EACH HST unit to 3.5”.
2. Sew the block together:
  - a. Follow the diagram and be sure to orient Row 1 & 4 correctly to create the **Kitty in the Corner** block



3. Press the block.
4. Square up the block to 12.5.”

Your “*Kitty in the Corner*” Block is ready to use!
