# "Attic Windows" Scrappy Block 12.5" x 12.5"

## Fabric scraps to pull from your stash:

For **EACH** block, pull or cut:


**Lights**: (2) 4.5" squares, (1) 5" squares (HST units) **Mediums**: (3) 4.5" squares, (1) 5" square (HST units) **Darks**: (2) 4.5" squares; (1) 5" square (HST units)

#### Create block:

- 1. Create the HST units as follows:
  - a. Place a Light & Medium 5" square RST and a Medium & Dark 5" square RST; draw one diagonal line from corner to corner on each pair. Sew a SCANT ¼" SA (seam allowance) on EACH SIDE of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line. Open and Press to the darker side. Square up EACH HST unit to 4.5". Each block requires (1) Lt/Med HST and (1) Med/Dark HST. (You will have an extra HST of each color combination to use on another block.)

## 2. Sew the block together:

a. Follow the diagram and be sure to orient Row 1 & 3 correctly to create the **Attic Window** block



- 3. Press the block.
- 4. Square up the block to 12.5."
