“June Wedding Ring” Scrappy Block 12.5” x 12.5”

Fabric scraps to pull from your stash:

Lights (Pale pinks & yellow): (4) 3.5” Pale pink squares (trim each square to 3-3/8”); (2) 5” squares (cut in half & trim to create (4) 2.5” x 4.5” rectangles); and (1) 4.5” yellow square.

Mediums (Greens): (2) 5” squares (cut in half & trim to create (4) 2.5” x 4.5” rectangles); (2) 3” squares (cut on the diagonal to create a total of (4) triangles).

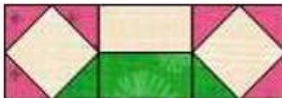
Darks (Dk. Pinks): (6) 3” squares (cut each on the diagonal to create a total of (12) triangles.)



Create the Block:

1. Create Corner units as follows: Trim each of the (4) 3.5” Light squares to 3-3/8””; Cut the (6) 3” Darks on the diagonal to obtain (12) Dark triangles; and cut the (2) 3” Mediums on the diagonal to create (4) triangles. Press creases in the centers of each square and each triangle. Use the creases to line up (3) Dark triangles and (1) Medium triangle around each 3-3/8” Light square. Sew, press, and trim up each corner unit to 4.5”.
2. Sew the rectangles (2.5” x 4.5” Light & Mediums) together and square up each unit to 4.5”
3. Piece the (3) Rows of the block together as shown below.

Row One:

Row Three:



4. Press; Square up the block to 12.5”.
