# "Rose Tulip Block" Scrappy Block $12.5 " \times 12.5 "$

## Fabric scraps to pull from your stash:

Lights: (3) 5" squares (2 for HST's \& 1 for rectangle); (3) 4.5" squares; (1) 2.5 " square
Mediums: (1) 4.5 " square; (1) 2.5 " square; (2) 5 " squares (HST's)

## Create the Block:

1. First, create the Corner Rosebud unit: Cut (1) 5 " Light square in half and then trim away $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from the length to obtain a $2.5 " x 4.5 "$ light rectangle. Using the $2.5 " \times 4.5 "$ light rectangle, along with the 2.5 " Medium \& Light squares, sew
 together the Corner Rosebud unit.
2. Create a total of (4) HST units using (2) Medium and (2) Light 4.5" squares. Place the Medium \& Light 4.5" squares RST; draw a diagonal line; sew a scant $1 / 4$ " on EACH side of the drawn line. Cut on drawn line. Press open the SA and trim up each HST unit to 4.5".
3. Piece the Rose Tulip Block together in 3 rows of 3 units as shown. NOTE Use the 4.5 " squares, the HST units and the Corner unit to create the block. Be sure to orient each unit properly within the block as shown in the diagram below:

4. Once sewn together, press \& square up the block to 12.5 ".
