“Sailboat” Scrappy Block 12.5” x 12.5”

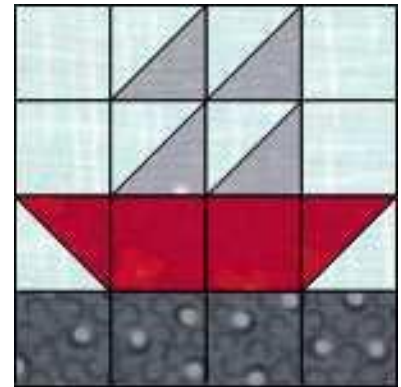
Fabric scraps to pull from your stash:

Lights: (4) 3.5” squares; (3) 4” squares for HST’s

Mediums: (Gray) (2) 4” squares for HST’s

Darks: (Red): (2) 3.5” squares; (1) 4” square for HST’s

Darks: (Deep blue) (4) 3.5” squares



Create the Block:

1. First, create the HST units: Place (2) Light Blue 4” squares RST with (2) Gray 4” squares AND place (1) Light Blue 4” square RST with (1) Red 4” square. Draw diagonal line from corner to corner on each pair. Sew SCANT ¼” SA on EACH side of drawn line. Cut on Drawn line. Square up to 3.5” and press SA (to the dark or open). You will have (4) Light/Gray HST’s & (2) Lt/Red HST’s.
2. Piece the Sailboat Block together in 4 rows of 4 units as shown. NOTE: Be sure to orient each HST unit properly within the block to create the sails and the boat.

3. Once sewn together, press & square up the block to 12.5”.

Your “*Sailboat*” Block is ready to use!
