Scrap Block Quilt Sampler – 52-week Series

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“Starlight” Scrappy Block 12.5” x 12.5”

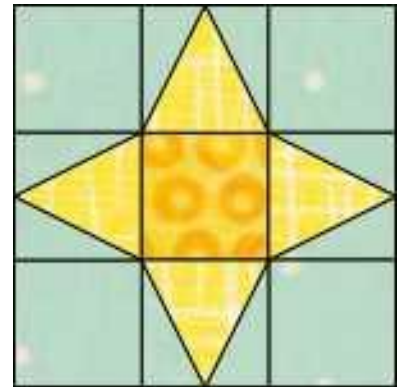
Fabric scraps to pull from your stash:

Lights: (4) 4.5” squares (sky); (4) 2.5” x 4.5” (Template C’s); (4) 2.5” x 4.5” (Template B’s);

Mediums: (Various Yellows) (5) 4.5” (center square & Template D’s)

Create the Block:

1. Trace the templates (B, C, & D) onto plastic template film. Cut out the templates.
2. Place the B & C Templates on Light 2.5” x 4.5” fabric rectangles; trace & cut a total of (4) B’s & (4) C’s from the Light fabrics.
3. Trace & cut Template D onto (4) Yellow 4.5” fabric squares.
4. Piece the Star points together using Templates B & C Light fabrics sewn onto each side of the Template D yellow fabrics. Press & square up the units to 4.5” square.
5. Piece the Starlight Block together in 3 rows of 3 units as shown. NOTE: Be sure to orient the Star Point units properly within the block to create the stars.

6. Once sewn together, press & square up the block to 12.5”.

Your “*Starlight*” Block is ready to use!
