



Part Six: Kaleidoscope Block

Quilt Size: 53" x 41"

Block Size: 9" (finished size in quilt) Cornerstones: 3" (finished) Sashing: 3" x 12" (finished)





"Kaleidoscope Block" (9.5" x 9.5" unfinished block size)

Fabric Requirements for the Quilt:

Background (Light blue): $1 - \frac{1}{4}$ yards

Bright blue: 1/8 yard Medium pink (B): ½ yard

Backing: 2 yards

Medium blue (A): 1/8 yard

Light pink: 3/8 yard

Dark pink: 1/8 yard

Binding: ½ yard

Medium blue (B): 7/8 yard

Medium pink (A): 7/8 yard

Batting: Approx. 60" x 45"

Plastic Template film: You will need plastic template film for this block to create the Kaleidoscope template pieces A & B. (Plastic templates can be purchased at your favorite quilt shop, Hobby Lobby, JoAnn's, and online. Here is a link to the Hobby Lobby plastic template so you'll know what I'm referring to: HERE

Cutting:

(Always substitute the color of fabrics you plan to use for those listed below...)

Light Blue background: (4) 5" squares (or 5" WOF strips)

Medium Pink: (4) 5" squares (or 5" WOF strips)



Directions:

- 1. Trace Template A (Kite shaped) & B (Triangle shaped) onto the plastic template film. Be sure to trace ON THE **DOTTED** lines to include the ¼" seam allowance (SA).
- 2. Then trace (4) Template A pieces onto the wrong side of Light Blue Background fabric. Cut on the drawn lines.
- 3. Then trace (4) Template B pieces onto the wrong side of Medium Pink fabric. Cut on the drawn lines.
- 4. Sew in units of (4) A-B fabrics. Place a B (Triangle shaped) Light Background fabric RST with an A Kite shaped Medium Pink fabric. Sew1/4" SA from top edge down to the pointed edge. Do this (4) times to make the (4) A/B units. Press the SA open.
- 5. Then, sew (2) of the A/B units together to create the top and bottom of the block.
- 6. Last, sew the top and bottom of the block together.
- 7. Press all seams open.
- 8. Then, SQUARE up the block to 9.5" square.

Congratulations! The "Kaleidoscope" block is finished! See you in a few weeks for the next block in the series!
