



## Part Eight: Ohio StarBlock

### Sampler Quilt Beginner Quilt Class 2023

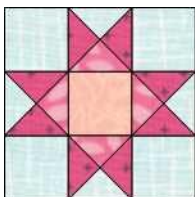
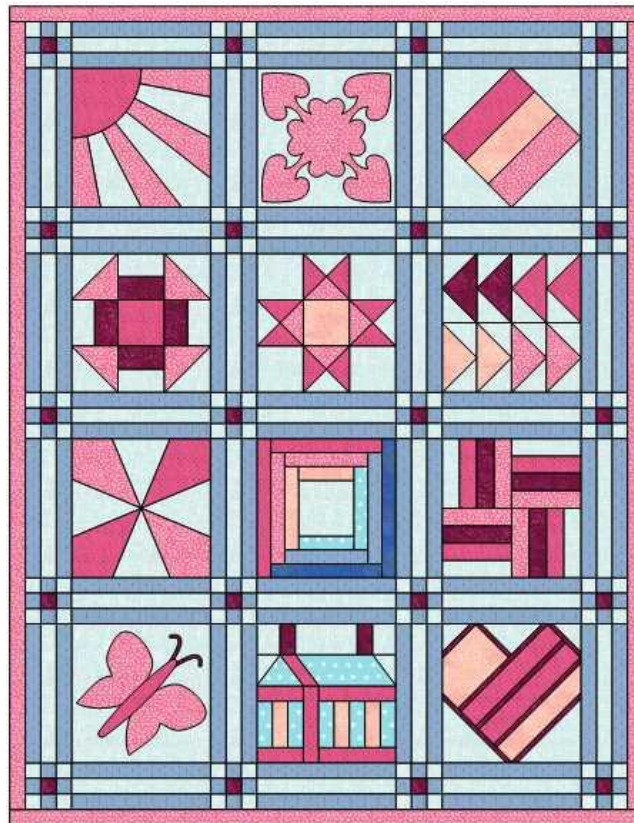
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Quilt Size: 53" x 41"

Block Size: 9" (finished size in quilt)

Cornerstones: 3" (finished)

Sashing: 3" x 12" (finished)



"Ohio Star Block" (9.5" x 9.5" unfinished block size)

#### Fabric Requirements for the Quilt:

Background (Light blue): 1 – ¼ yards

Bright blue: 1/8 yard

Medium pink (B): ½ yard

Backing: 2 yards

Medium blue (A): 1/8 yard

Light pink: 3/8 yard

Dark pink: 1/8 yard

Binding: ½ yard

Medium blue (B): 7/8 yard

Medium pink (A): 7/8 yard

Batting: Approx. 60" x 45"



### **Cutting:**

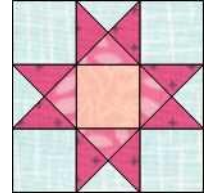
Always substitute the color of fabrics you plan to use for those listed below.

Light Blue background: (4) 3.5” squares; (4) Triangle Template B

Light Pink: (1) 3.5” square (center)

Med. Pink: (4) Triangle Template B

Med. Pink 2: (8) Triangle Template B



**Supplies:** Either Template Plastic film, OR an Easy Angle Ruler. (See video)

### **Directions:**

1. Cut a 2.5” WOF strip from Light Background, Med. Pink & Med. Pink 2 fabrics.
2. Either create a Plastic Template of Template B and trace the template onto (4) Med. Pinks, (4) Light Backgrounds, and (8) Med. Pink 2 fabrics; or, use the Easy Angle ruler (follow the Video directions) to create the (4) Med Pink, (4) Light Background, and (8) Med. Pink 2 Triangles.
  - a. To create the QST’s (Quarter-square triangle units): WATCH VIDEO INSTRUCTIONS... sew a Light Background Triangle to a Med. Pink 2 Triangle.
  - b. Then sew a Med. Pink 2 Triangle to a Med. Pink Triangle.
  - c. Now, sew those triangle units together to complete the QST unit.
  - d. Repeat steps 2 through 4 to create a total of (4) QST units.
3. Layout the (3) rows for the block as follows:



Row One: Sew Lt. Background 3.5” square to each side of a QST unit. (Be sure to orient each QST unit within each row correctly ... Follow the diagram.



Row Two: Sew a Light Pink 3.5” square between (2) QST units.



Row Three: Sew a Lt. Background 3.5” square to each side of a QST unit.



4. Now sew those 3 rows together.
5. **SQUARE up the block to 9.5” square.**

Congratulations! The “Ohio Star” block is finished!
