


Quilt Size: 53" x 41" Block Size: 9" (finished size in quilt) Cornerstones: 3" (finished) Sashing: 3" x 12" (finished)

# Fabric Requirements for the <u>Quilt</u>:

Background (Light blue): 1 – ¼ yards Bright blue: 1/8 yard Medium pink (B): ½ yard Backing: 2 yards Medium blue (A): 1/8 yard Light pink: 3/8 yard Dark pink: 1/8 yard Binding: <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> yard Medium blue (B): 7/8 yard Medium pink (A): 7/8 yard

Batting: Approx. 60" x 45"



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
#### **Cutting:**

Always substitute the color of fabrics you plan to use for those listed below.

Light Blue background: (1) 9.5" square Med. Pink 1: (1) 9.5" square

#### Supplies:

Print the Pdf of template for Hawaiian applique block at 100% Applique thread (100 weight applique thread is best) #10 Sharp needles Applique pins Marking pen (erasable or chalk)



## Directions:

- 1. Print out the PDF at 100%. Use a paper scissors & cut it out on the DOTTED LINES! For Needleturn applique you NEED the <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" seam allowances provided in the PDF.
- 2. Pin the applique PDF to your fabric; cut it out.
- 3. Mark the  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances using your marking pen or chalk.
- 4. Thread your needle.
- 5. Center your applique on the block by folding & pressing the background block in quarters (vertically & horizontally).
- 6. Align the fabric on the background block.
- 7. Begin by stitching from the back of your background block and bring the needle up right ON the marked line ... find a straight spot on the applique to begin. Turn the marked seam allowance under as you stitch. (Hence, the name "needle-turn".)
- 8. Take a small stitch in the background fabric; then come up and take a small stitch in the applique fabric. Continue around, folding under at corners, clip into seam allowances as you go around curves to make the fabric turn under more easily.
- 9. When finished, tie off on the back of the background square.

## 10. Be sure your background block is SQUARED up to 9.5" square.

Congratulations! The "Hawaiian applique" block is finished!
