



## Part Twelve: Stained Glass Heart Block

### Sampler Quilt Beginner Quilt Class 2023

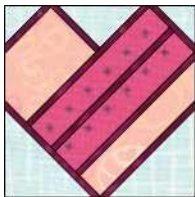
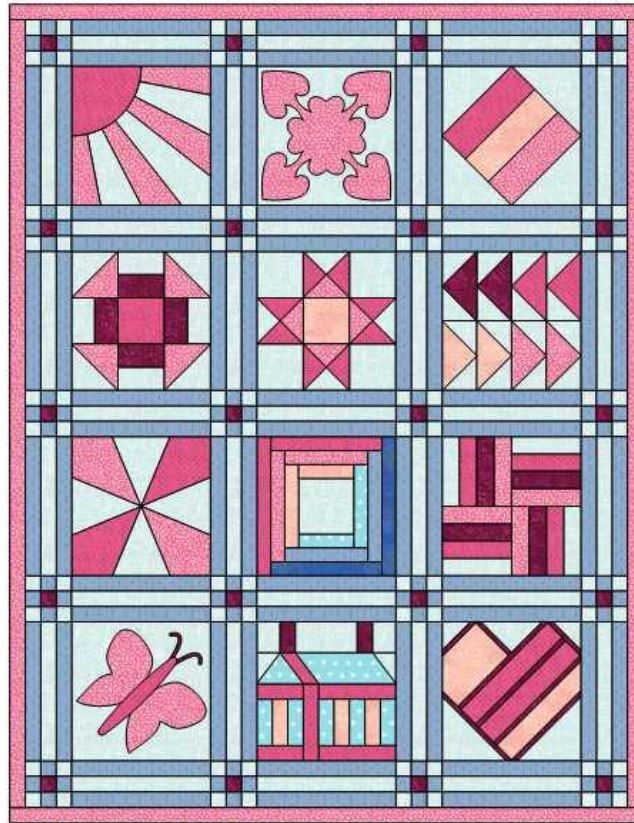
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Quilt Size: 53" x 41"

Block Size: 9" (finished size in quilt)

Cornerstones: 3" (finished)

Sashing: 3" x 12" (finished)



“Stained Glass Heart” (9.5” x 9.5” unfinished block size)

#### Fabric Requirements for the Quilt:

Background (Light blue): 1 – ¼ yards

Bright blue: 1/8 yard

Medium pink (B): ½ yard

Backing: 2 yards

Medium blue (A): 1/8 yard

Light pink: 3/8 yard

Dark pink: 1/8 yard

Binding: ½ yard

Medium blue (B): 7/8 yard

Medium pink (A): 7/8 yard

Batting: Approx. 60” x 45”



**Cutting:**

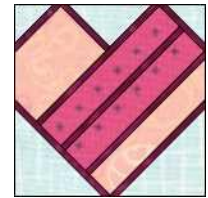
Always substitute the color of fabrics you plan to use for those listed below.

Light Blue background: (1) 2.75” square [Template D]; (1) 3.5” square [Template A];  
(1) 5” square [Template C].

Light Pink: (1) 3.5” x 5.25” rectangle [Trim the Lt Pink rectangle to match Template F];  
(1) 1-7/8” x 8-1/4” rectangle [Trim the Lt. Pink Rectangle to match Template E.

Med. Pink 1: (2) 1-7/8” x 8.5” rectangles [Template B]

Dark Fabric: Cut WOF strip 7/8” wide. From this strip you will cut lengths to create the stain glass portion of the block. (See directions below.)



**Directions:** (PRESS ALL SEAM ALLOWANCES TO THE DARK AS YOU SEW.)

1. Cut the fabrics in the colors & sizes noted above.
2. From Light Background fabric, cut each of the squares on the diagonal to create triangles needed for the block. (Note: You will only use one of the triangles from the 3.75” square.)
3. From the 7/8” WOF strip, cut (3) 3-5/8” strips, cut (2) 7” strips, cut (3) 8.5” strips.
4. Piece an 8.5” Dark strip to EACH long side of a Med Pink rectangle. Add a Med Pink rectangle to the long side.
5. Sew another 8.5” Dark strip to the second Med Pink rectangle, and then add a Lt. Pink Rectangle.
6. Sew a 7” Dark strip to the opposite side of the Lt. Pink Rectangle. (WATCH VIDEO!)
7. Sew a Dark strip to the Med Pink short ends as shown IN VIDEO! Add one of the Light Background Triangles to finish off the top right-hand corner of the block.
8. Sew the 3.5” end of the Lt. Pink Template F to a Dark strip. Attach the Light Background Triangle A to that unit. (WATCH VIDEO!)
9. Sew a Dark strip to the remaining 3.5” side of the Lt Pink Template F. Add one of the Light Background Triangles to finish off the top left-hand corner of the block.
10. Add Dark strip to the ends of the Lt Pink/Med Pink section of the heart.
11. Finish off the bottom corners of the block with a Light Background triangle. Press your block!
12. **Be sure your background block is SQUARED up to 9.5” square.**

Congratulations! The “Stained Glass Heart” block is finished!
