Part FOUR-Border TWO (Queen Size) & Border (Wall Size)

If you don't already have your scrap stash cut, sorted, organized and ready to go to make beautiful quilts, be sure to watch/listen to my YouTube video tutorial here: <u>LINK</u> This link will take you to my YouTube channel and you'll find the tutorial is that top video listed on the channel right under my QWL Welcome banner.

If you do NOT have a scrap stash, NO WORRIES! All my patterns offer yardage to create the quilt. The yardage required for *Dutchman's Crossing* is listed below. PLUS, I have available some Resource Links on my website to give you some wonderful fabric options from which to choose: Check out the Strawberry Lemonade fabric line on <u>The Fat Quarter Shop</u>; or the True Blue fabric line on <u>Connecting Threads</u>.

<u>Fabric requirements for 90" x 90" quilt size:</u> Light fabric: 2.25 yards (mine will be creams) Medium 1 fabric: 2-3/8 yards (mine will be soft greens) Medium 2 fabric: 2-1/8 yards (mine will be soft roses) Dark fabric: 2-5/8 yards (mine will be blacks/charcoals)

Border Two: QUEEN SIZE – 90" x 90"

Note: Fabric colors indicated in the block image are only suggestions! Create your own unique quilt blocks; scrappy or themed! Use scrap fabrics or fabric lines that please you!

CUT the following:

Inside, Middle & Outside Dark Borders:

(4) 1.5" x 74.5" (Inside)
(2) 1.5" x 80.5" (Middle)
(2) 1.5" x 82.5" (Middle)
(2) 1.5" x 88.5" (Outside)
(2) 1.5" x 90.5" (Outside)

(Rectangle) Border A:

From 2.5" WOF strips, cut the following:
(4) Dark (Black) 2.5" x 9.75"
(16) Medium #1 (Green) 2.5" x 9.75"
(8) Medium #2 (Pink) 2.5" x 9.75"
(8) Light (White) 2.5" x 5-1/8"
(4) Light (White) 2.5" x 2.5" squares
(8) Medium #2 (Pinks) 2.5" x 1.5" rectangles
(4) Medium #1 (Greens) 1.5" x 1.5" squares

Using Plastic Template Film, trace a Large Triangle and an End Triangle & a Reverse End Triangle on the DOTTED lines (1/4" seam allowance is required). Cut out the templates and trace them onto the Wrong side of the appropriate fabrics (See below...

Using 3.5" WOF (width of fabric) strips from your stash, or 3.5" WOF strips that you've cut from your yardage, TRACE the Templates and CUT the following:
Large Triangles:
(32) Medium #1 (Green)
(16) Light (White)
(16) Medium #2 (Pink)
(4) Dark (Black)

End Triangles:

(4) Dark (Black)(4) REVERSED Dark (Black)

Corners: (4) 3.5" x 3.5" Dark (Black) squares



Inside Dark Border:

Piece the Dark (Black) 1.5" x 74.5" borders to the top & bottom of the quilt center. Add a 1.5" Med #1 (Green) corner square to EACH end of the remaining (2) 1.5" x 74.5" Dark borders and sew them to the remaining (2) sides of the quilt. Press SA to the dark borders.

Piece the (Rectangle) Border A:

Follow the diagram to piece the **Top** and **Bottom** Rectangle Border A's, using (2) 2.5" x 1.5" Med #2 rectangles, (2) 2.5" x 5 1/8" Light rectangles, (4) 2.5" x 9.75" Med #1 rectangles, (2) 2.5" x 9.75" Med #2 rectangle, and (1) 2.5" x 9.75" Dark rectangle. **Sew these (2) borders to the Top and Bottom** of the quilt center.

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Follow the diagram below to piece (2) **SIDE Rectangle Border A's** (the same as the top & bottom except you will add the 2.5" Light corner square to EACH end of both borders. Then sew these borders to the sides of the quilt center.

Middle Dark Border:

Piece the Dark (Black) 1.5" x 80.5" borders to the top & bottom of the quilt center. Sew the remaining (2) 1.5" x 82.5" Dark borders to the sides of the quilt. Press SA to the dark borders.

Piece the Triangle Border B:

Following the diagram below, create **a Top and a Bottom border** using (1) End Dark Triangle, (1) Reverse End Dark Triangle, (8) Med. #1 (Green) Large Triangles; (4) Med #2 (Pink) Large Triangles; (4) Light (White) Large Triangles and (1) Dark (Black) Large Triangle for EACH Border. NOTE: Follow Video instructions on piecing the Triangles. Create (2) of these borders and then sew one to the Top and one to the Bottom of the Quilt Center. ORIENT each border so the Black triangles point away from center.



Following the diagram below, create the (2) Side Triangle Borders using (2) 3.5" x 3.5" Dark (Black) squares; (1) End Dark Triangle, (1) Reverse End Dark Triangle, (1) Dark (Black) Large Triangle, (4) Light (White) Large Triangles, (4) Med #2 (Pink) Large Triangles, and (8) Med #1 (Green) Large Triangles for EACH Side Border. Create (2) of these borders and then sew one to EACH side of the quilt center. ORIENT the Side borders so that the Black Triangle points AWAY from the center of the quilt.






Queen Size quilt continued....

Outer Dark Borders:

Piece the Dark (Black) 1.5" x 88.5" borders to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Sew the remaining (2) 1.5" x 90.5" Dark borders to the sides of the quilt. Press SA to the dark borders.

Congratulations! Your QUEEN SIZE quilt is ready to be quilted, bound and labeled!!

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WALL QUILT:

Plastic Template: Trace and cut out the various Triangles... trace ON the dotted line (must include the seam allowances). Cut out the templates on that dotted line and trace them on the wrong side of fabric.


Cutting:

From 4.5" WOF strips (stash or yardage), cut (8) Med #2 (Pinks) Large Triangle A's and (4) Dark (Black) Large Triangle A's. From 2.5" WOF strips (stash or yardage), cut (24) Light (White) Triangle B's. From 5" WOF strips (stash or yardage) out (8) Mod #1 (Green)

From 5" WOF strips (stash or yardage) cut (8) Med #1 (Green) Small Triangle C's

From 4.25" WOF strips (stash or yardage) cut (8) Med #1 (Greens) Diamond Templates.

Cut: (4) 1.5" x 62.50" Dark (Black) Cut: (4) 1.5" squares Med #1 (Green) or Light (White) -your choice... Cut: (4) 4.5" squares Med #2 (Pinks)




Piece the Top and Bottom borders using the following for EACH border: (2) Med #1 (Green) Small Triangle C's; (2) Med #2 (Pink) Large Triangle A's; (2) Med #1 (Green) Diamond Templates; (1) Dark (Black) Large Tringle A and (6) Light (White) Triangle B's. Sew the Top & Bottom Borders to the quilt center. ORIENT the Black Triangle points AWAY from the quilt center. (**Diagrams on next page**....)



Top Border

Bottom Border


Piece the (2) Side borders using the following for **EACH border**: (2) Med #1 (Green) Small Triangle C's; (2) Med #2 (Pink) Large Triangle A's; (2) Med #1 (Green) Diamond templates; (1) Dark (Black) Large Tringle A; (6) Light (White) Triangle B's; and (2) Med #2 (Pink) 4.5" squares. Sew the Side Borders to the quilt center. ORIENT the Black triangle points AWAY from the quilt center.



Outer Dark Borders:

Sew a Dark 1.5" x 62.5" border to the top and bottom of the quilt.

Sew a 1.5" Med #1 (Green) square to EACH end of the remaining (2) Dark 1.5" x 62.5" borders. Then sew those last two borders to the sides of the quilt.



Congratulations! Your Wall Size Quilt is ready to be quilted, bound and labeled! Don't forget to add a sleeve so you can hang it!
