

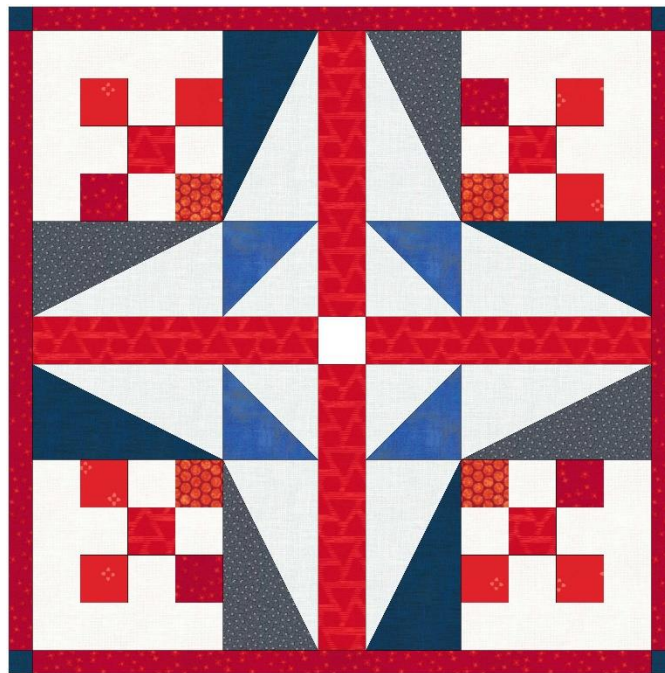

Scrappy Independence Day Bouquet 12.5" square blocks (unfinished)



Quilt Dimensions: 28" x 28" (Blocks: 12" – finished size)



Make 4 blocks

Use: (5) 2.5" red & (4) 2.5" white squares for the 9-patch; (2) 2.5" x 6.5" white strips & (1) 2.5" white square around the 9-patch.

Use 5" x 9" rectangles in white & blue for stems (be sure to make one rectangle set in reverse image for each block). Cut the rectangles on the diagonal. Sew them together on the diagonal; press toward the dark. Square up the Half Square Rectangle to 4.5" x 8.5"

Use 5" white & blue squares to create HST. (HST must be squared up to 4.5")

Sashing: 2.5" x 12.5" (red strips of fabric – SOF)

Center Corner Stone" White 2.5" square

Outer borders: I used 2" SOF in red and (4) 2" blue squares

Square up each Block to 12.5"

Rotate each block within the quilt so the red/white 'bouquet' is pointed toward the outer corners of the quilt.
