



## “Steps to Glory!” Scrappy Block 12.5” x 12.5”

### Fabric scraps to pull from your stash:

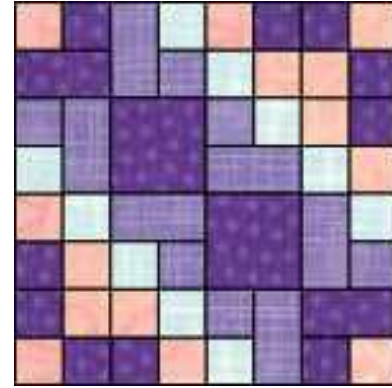
To create block:

**Lights:** Light Blue (10) 2” squares; Pink (14) 2.” squares

**Medium:** (6) 2” squares; (6) 2”x 3.5” strips

**Darks:** (10) 2.” Squares; (2) 2” x 3.5” strips; and (2) 3.5” squares

Create the Block:



1. Piece (2) corner 3-patch units (top left & bottom right) using (2) Pink 2” squares and (2) 2” Dark squares, along with (2) 2” x 3.5” strips. Square up the (2) units to 3.5” square.



2. Piece the remaining (2) corner 4-patch units using (4) 2” squares & (4) 2” Darks. Square up the (2) units to 3.5” square.



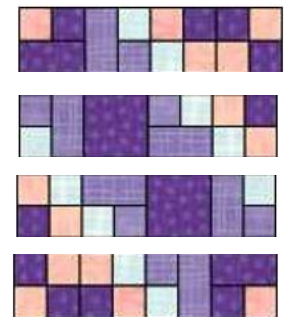
3. Piece (4) of the inside 4-patch units as follows using (8) Pink 2” squares, (4) Dark 2” squares and (4) Light Blue 2” squares as shown at right. Square up the (4) units to 3.5” square.



4. Piece the remaining (6) 3-patch units as follows using (6) Light Blue 2” squares, (6) Medium 2” squares; and (6) 2”x 3.5” Medium strips. Square up the (6) units to 3.5” square.

5. Lay out the block in 4 rows of units as shown below, using the (2) 3.5” Dark squares in the center of the block. Be sure to orient all units correctly within the block.

- a. Row One (see diagram at right....)
- b. Row Two
- c. Row Three
- d. Row Four



6. Once sewn together, press & square up the block to 12.5”.

Your “*Steps to Glory*” Block is ready to use!
