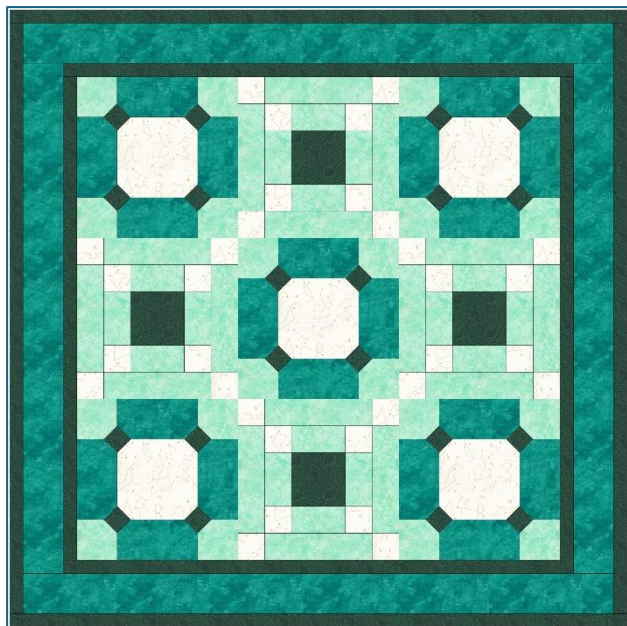




Alabama Magic Quilt

Two's Company

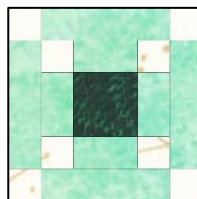
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Wall Quilt: 46" x 46"

Fabric Yardage:

White: ½ yard – Cut (5) 6.5" center of Magic Circle blocks and (32) 2.5" squares for Log Cabin blocks

Dark Teal: 7/8 yard – Cut (20) 3.5" x 6.5" rectangles; Borders: Cut (2) 3.5" x 38.5" & (2) 3.5" x 44.5"

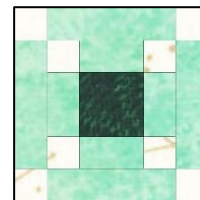
Light Teal: ¾ yard – (20) 3.5" squares; (16) 2.5" x 4.5" rectangles; (16) 2.5" x 8.5" rectangles.

Black: ¾ yard – Cut (40) 1.5" squares (for Snowballing Blocks); (4) 4.5" squares; Borders: (2) 1.5" x 36.5"; (2) 1.5" x 38.5"; (2) 1.5" x 44.5"; and (2) 1.5" x 46.5".

Magic Circle Blocks: Create the 5 blocks by snowballing one corner of each of the 3.5" squares and snowball all four corners of the 6.5" white squares with the 1.5" black squares. Log Cabin Blocks: Attach Light Teal (8) 2.5" x 4.5" rectangles to sides of (4) Black 4.5" squares. Sew white 2.5" squares on both ends of (8) 2.5" x 4.5" Light Teal rectangles and sew to top/bottom of those units. Then, sew (8) 2.5" x 8.5" Light Teal rectangles to the sides. Sew white 2.5" squares on both ends of (8) 2.5" x 8.5" Light Teal rectangles and sew to top/bottom of those units. **WATCH VIDEO TUTORIAL!**



Layout: Sew the 9 blocks together in a 9-patch formation. Attach the shorter Inside Black borders; then the longer Inside Black borders. Attach the shorter Dark Teal borders; then the longer Dark Teal borders. Attach the shorter Outside Black borders; then the longer Outside Black borders.

Create Larger quilt by making MORE Magic Circle & Log Cabin blocks from your stash! Happy Quilting!
