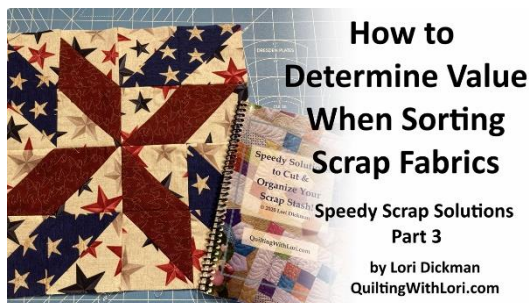

“Cross with a Crown” Squares and Instructions for the block:



You may use Light, Medium and Dark value squares in the block (as shown).
OR you may reverse the values! Have fun with your scraps!

For EACH Block Pull:

3” squares: (2) Light value cut once on diagonal

3.5” squares: (8) Dark value; (1) Medium value

4” squares: (4) Medium value cut once on diagonal (2) Light value cut once on diagonal

1. (Center) Sew a Dark 3.5” square to each side of a Medium 3.5” square. Sew a Light triangle to each end of the dark squares to complete the center row.
2. Sew a Light triangle (diagonal cut from 4” squares) to each side of a 3.5” Dark square. Do this twice.
3. Sew a Light 3” triangle (diagonal cut from 3” squares) to the top of each unit created in Step 2.
4. Sew the unit (Step 1) in between the two units created in Step 2 & 3 to create the center block. Square up the block to 9” square.
5. Create (4) of the following corner units: Sew a 4” Medium value triangle to perpendicular sides of a 3.5” Dark square.
6. Sew the (4) corner units to the Center block.
7. Press all seams to the dark side OR press seams open, whichever you prefer.
8. Square up the “Cross with a Cross” Block to 12.5” square.
